




# THE MATCHMAKER

## Act I: Vandergelder's Provisions

ITEM	DESCRIPTION	REFERENCE
Desk	Should look masculine and be small and easy to get off stage. Include some set dressing similar to the photo at right. Books, papers, letters, etc. Should be Walnut wood finish.	
Desk Chair	Walnut chair on castors.	
Antique Cash Register	Doesn't need to function. Able to be moved quickle and easily during scene change.

Pedestal Table	Walnut or Oak. Also used in the hat shoppe.	
(2) Ladderback Chairs	Oak or Walnut with natural caning.	
Various cans, boxes, set dressing.	Neatly organized and displayed on the shelves on the counter unit.

<p>Coat/hat tree</p>	<p>Bentwood.</p>	
<p>Ladder</p>	<p>Wooden ship's ladder. Runs from trap door into orchestra pit.</p>	



# THE MATCHMAKER

## Act II: Mrs. Molloy's Hat Shoppe



ITEM	DESCRIPTION	REFERENCE
Curtain Rods	Antique brass finish. Decorative finial ends.	
Half Curtains (2)	Ruffle chiffon. See drafting for dimensions. Cream color.	
Curtains (2 sets)	Floral print in the cream/pastel pink or yellow realm.	See rendering.
Tablecloth	Similar or same fabric as curtains with lacy ruffles around. Should fit square pedestal table from Act I. Check with director for preferred length.	



# THE MATCHMAKER

(2) Bentwood Chairs	Natural wood color or painted cream. Preferably with decorative curvy back as pictured.	
(2) Tall Hat Displays	Similar to those shown in the painting at right, but able to hold 3 hats each. Think candelabra.

<p>Tabletop Hat Displays</p>	<p>Various heights. Consider using candlesticks with added padding to top and embellishments.</p>	
<p>Various hats, ribbons, flowers, etc.</p>	<p>Displayed on hat stands. Plus supplies for decorating hats.</p>

Full-Length Cheval Mirror	Match to color of bentwood chairs. Some type of fancy or curvy silhouette.

(2) Round Café Tables	Around 30-36" in diameter.	
(6) Bentwood Chairs	Dark wood finish. Caning or upholstered seat.

<p>Menus</p>	<p>One long page with nice border. Use Harmonia Gardens logo at the top. Should be printed on a sturdy paper.</p>	
<p>Dishware</p>	<p>Simple but elegant.</p>

ITEM	DESCRIPTION	REFERENCE
Victorian Chandelier	Flown. Practical. See drafting for approximate dimensions.	
Victorian Sofa	With antimacassars and throw pillows. Dark walnut or mahogany wood finish. Upholstery to be similar to curtains. Burgundy floral damask pattern fabric.	




